The present Church building was built in 1875. The bell in the bell tower is still functioning and is rung for afternoon programs. The church has multiple stained glass windows and a pipe organ. A Bible from 1890 and a hymnal dated 1902 are on display in the Church.

EBENEZER UNITED METHODIST CHURCH



205 Locust St., Cynthiana

The Church was built in 1892. Most of the Church was destroyed in the flood of 1997, but many members were able to salvage the original pews and railings. The circular window behind the pulpit was designed in such a way that when the sun shines through the window, it looks like stars are shining.

CYNTHIANA CHRISTIAN CHURCH



202 North Main Street, Cynthiana

The Church was built in 1899. The architecture of the church is a blend of Romanesque, Byzantine and early Gothic. This church is only one of two buildings in Cynthiana that used stones from the McGibbin Quarry. This quarry was located where the high school parking lot now stands.

CHURCH OF THE ADVENT EPISCOPAL



118 North Walnut Street, Cynthiana

The first Episcopal church in Cynthiana was established in 1835. The Church was constructed of native stone of Harrison County using the uncoursed method (different sized stones). The bell was placed in the tower in 1876 and came from Cincinnati. It is thought that the Church may have been a Civil War Hospital.

FIRST UNITED METHODIST CHURCH



302 East Pike Street, Cynthiana

The present Church was built in 1905. The church is built of pressed brick with stone trimming and has a metal shingle roof. The pews and alter are original and made of solid oak. The main auditorium has a high dome which houses a large, exquisite stained glass window.

CYNTHIANA PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH



103 North Main Street, Cynthiana

The Church was built in 1879 and is the second oldest church in Cynthiana. The Church is a red brick Gothic structure with a lofty tower at the northeast front corner and high Gothic windows of stained glass.

CYNTHIANA BAPTIST CHURCH



212 East Pleasant Street, Cynthiana

The church was dedicated in 1915. The style of the building is Classic Renaissance of the Grecian order. The main auditorium is decorated with 6 large windows of Ionic design, distinguished only by the emblem in the upper central section and the names of those whom they memorialize. The educational building was added in 1963.
